1. Exhibitors are limited to one (1) entry in the performance class.
2. Eligible females must be born on or before September 1, 2017.
3. Cows show with their most recent calf at side.
4. Entries should not be highly groomed. They should be washed and clipped with no hair pull or tail balling.
5. Performance records must be obtained as a part of a breed association or state performance testing program. Identification on the record must match the tattoo in the cow's ear. A copy of the cow's performance record must be presented to the superintendent. Aged cows should have a completed performance cow card for the judge's reference. The cow card should itemize the performance of each calf weaned from the cow.

An overall Grand Champion Performance Cow/Calf will be named and receive a rosette.

Beef Steer Division

Please enter the steer division by the breed. They will be placed into the proper class after being weighed.

A Champion and Reserve Champion Steer will be named in the following breeds:

*Angus, Simmental, Shorthorn, Hereford & Crossbred
Each will receive a rosette.*

A Grand Champion and Reserve Grand Champion Steer will be named. Both will receive a rosette

An Overall Grand Champion Market Animal will also be named and receive a chair sponsored by ETC Women's Club.

Junior Show Rate of Gain

1. All steer exhibited in Junior Show will automatically be entered into this competition.
2. Steer will be weighed on Tuesday (Check for times).
3. Placing will be determined by rate of gain.
4. 1st place winner will be named Rate of Gain Champion; 2nd place will be named Reserve Champion and will receive a rosette.

Bucket Calf Class Registration

Rules:

1. Mason County Residents Only.
2. Only for individuals who are 8 and younger (at the time of the show).
3. Calves must be born in 2019 and not eligible for regular show.
4. All participants will received a ribbon and halter.
5. Exhibitors should be able to show his/her animal without additional help.
6. Animals must be on the grounds by the start of the Beef Show (9:00 a.m. on Wednesday).
7. The show will be held immediately following the conclusion of the Beef Show.
8. Written entries are required by July 1, 2019. NO LATE ENTRIES ACCEPTED.
9. Health papers are required and must be presented at the start of the show,
10. Please bring your own "penning" method for your calf if needed.
11. Animals are free to leave the grounds at the conclusion of the Bucket Calf Show.
